RULE 17 - DISCLOSURE OF AIR TOXICS INFORMATION (Adopted 4/17/90)

The requirements of the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act, Health and Safety Code Sections 44300 through 44384, shall apply to the following, except as provided in Health and Safety Code Sections 44323 through 44325:

- A. Any stationary source which is listed in any existing toxics use or toxics air emission survey, inventory, or report released or compiled by the District: or,
- B. Any stationary source which manufactures, formulates, uses, or releases any of the substances listed pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 44321 or any other substance which reacts to form a substance listed pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 44321; and
 - 1. Releases, or has the potential to release, more than 10 tons per year of total organic gases, particulate matter, nitrogen oxides, or sulfur oxides; or,
 - 2. Is identified pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 44322.(c).
