California Air Resources Board approves first AB32 Scoping Plan Update

Plan affirms California is on track to meet AB 32; calls on all sectors to reduce greenhouse gases, continue driving down emissions through 2020 and beyond

On May 22, the California Air Resources Board approved the first update to the AB 32 Scoping Plan. The update to the Scoping Plan will guide the continued development and implementation of California's efforts to fight climate change.

The update builds on the success of programs now in place and first outlined in the original 2008 Scoping Plan. Those programs are critical parts of a comprehensive plan that is successfully lowering the state's carbon intensity by reducing greenhouse gas emissions, protecting the environment, and driving innovation, job generation and clean energy.

"This plan builds on the success of California's current approach to fighting climate change, and reflects the latest science to expand those efforts beyond 2020," said Air Resources Board Chairman Mary D. Nichols.

"It establishes the framework for continued economic growth and promotes investments in communities and every economic sector to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and protect public health."

The update continues California's leadership in creating effective environmental and public health policies while building a world-class economy. The update highlights roles for the water, agriculture, forestry and natural resources sectors to both reduce greenhouse gas emissions and strengthen those sectors against the impacts of climate change.

The update also includes a comprehensive effort to fast-track reductions of 'short-lived climate pollutants' such as black carbon and methane. Their reduction will deliver significant public health and climate benefits in the very near-term. The update provides guidance for further emission reductions

from the transportation sector, including particular attention to freight and goods movement. It also looks more closely for related health and economic co-benefits between California's efforts to control smog and soot, and greenhouse gas emissions.

The updated Scoping plan also outlines how declines in auto emissions will continue in the coming years with larger numbers of cleaner, more fuel-efficient cars and

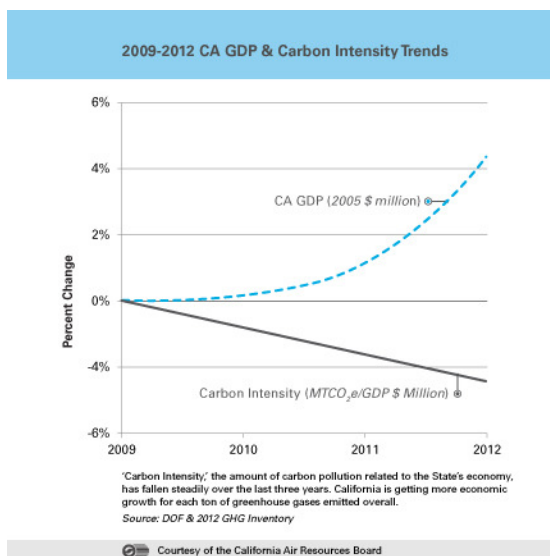

higher volumes of clean fuels. In addition to reducing emissions, California's suite of climate policies will continue to reduce fuel costs for California drivers. By 2020, California drivers will spend about 30 percent less on fuel than they did in 2012, on average, and will emit 30 percent fewer greenhouse gas emissions. Those cost and emissions savings will grow further after 2020.

AB 32 requires California to reduce overall greenhouse gas emissions to 1990 levels by 2020 and maintain and continue reductions beyond that date.

Record numbers for Bike-to-Work week. Cyclists participated in record-breaking numbers for the annual Bike to Work Week campaign presented by the Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) and Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (APCD). Final tallies revealed the most online participation and "pit stop" event attendance in campaign history with increases of 51 percent and 71 percent, respectively. The campaign ran from May 12-16.

Pit stops were held in several cities in the morning commute hours. At these events, attendees received free bike tune-ups, breakfast refreshments, and bike-related giveaways.

- Held the first of two statutorily-required public hearings on the **APCD Proposed Fiscal Year 2014-15 budget**. There is a two week opportunity for public

review and comment; the final budget is scheduled for adoption at a special APCD Board meeting on June 24. Contact **Nancy Mendoza** at **645-1402**.

• Approved the **2014 Reasonably Available Control Technology State Implementation Plan (2014 RACT SIP)** revision. The 2014 RACT SIP Revision demonstrates that all District rules applicable to

ozone precursor emissions meet or exceed RACT and fulfill RACT requirements for the federal 8-hour ozone attainment planning requirements under the federal Clean Air Act. This process is a necessary part of Ventura County's 8-hour ozone attainment planning requirements under the federal Clean Air Act. The SIP Revision will now be submitted to the California

Air Resources Board for transmittal to U.S. EPA as a formal revision to the California ozone SIP. For more information, contact **Chuck Thomas** at **645-1427**.

• Approved the proposal to change the APCD regular Board meetings to from 11 A.M. to **1:30 P.M.** This will take effect after July 1.

Exploring the great outdoors by camping, backpacking and hiking is a wonderful vacation, weekend trip, or day experience (especially in the summer!). And Ventura County has plenty of open spaces to enjoy and explore. But here, or in any wilderness area,

we need to be conscious of our impact on the environment. Here are a few “green” tips for your outdoor experience.

- Drastically reduce your trash by using reusable sturdy plates, utensils, and cups that can be washed with biodegradable, phosphate-free soap and used again.
- At the *old campfire*, don't burn plastic, metals or woods treated with chemicals.
- Use an LED lantern or flashlight.
- Use trash receptacles when available, otherwise, take care to take out everything you bring into your camping area. And that goes for the backcountry also. Never leave litter while hiking. Pack it out.
- And remember, campfire songs don't pollute.

Advisory Committee

The Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (VCAPCD) Advisory Committee met on June 24, 2014 to consider proposed amendments to Rule 26.13, New Source Review – Prevention of Significant Deterioration. Staff is proposing revisions to include updates required as a result of court decisions and clarifications regarding enforceability and responsible parties. New requirements address interagency notification requirements, application completeness determination, and applicant notification requirements. In addition, new subsections address greenhouse gas requirements and options for PSD permitting of power plants regulated by the California Energy Commission. The public participation requirements are also expanded and clarified in the proposed revisions. The Advisory Committee recommended that the Air Pollution Control Board approve the proposed amendments to Rule 26.13.
