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## **Agricultural Pump Repower Application - Page 3**

ARB regulations require uncontrolled engines (Tier 0) rated at 100 HP or more to be replaced by 12/31/2010. Engines rated between 50 HP and 100 HP must be replaced by 12/31/2011. No funds may be awarded for Tier 0 engines installed after the above compliance dates.

Applications for agricultural pump repowers are accepted on a continuous basis and are funded on a first-come-first serve basis as long as funds are available.

- (1) Maximum funding for diesel repower is 85% of the cost of the necessary equipment and related parts. Installation costs are not funded.
- (2) Existing Tier 1 and Tier 2 engines must be repowered with electric motors or Tier 4 engines to be eligible for funding.
- (3) Maximum funding for electric motors is 85% of the cost of the equipment, related parts, and installation costs, including labor. Costs for necessary peripheral equipment associated with electric motor projects (e.g. control panel, motor leads, service pole with guy wire, and connecting electric line from the meter) may be included in the grant award amount.
  - (A) Variable frequency devices are eligible for funding if the applicant provides justification for adjustable water needs.
  - (B) Reduced voltage starting ("soft start") technology is eligible for funding if required by the electric service provider.
- (4) Diesel engines greater than 50 hp must be registered with the local air district to be eligible for repower projects.

No funding is available to replace spark ignited (SI) engines (natural gas or gasoline) with diesel engines.

Portable engines owned by rental companies are not eligible for Carl Moyer Program funding.

All engines replaced as part of a repower project must be destroyed and rendered useless.
